Information to be Supplied at a Shidduch Meeting

When presenting a Single the following information should be given:

SPONSOR'S INFORMATION:

- Sponsor's Name
- Sponsor's Contact information: phone and/or email

SINGLE'S INFORMATION:

Rabbanim have advised L'Chaim to OMIT the name and/or initials of the single during the presentation. After the meeting, when appropriate interest is established, names should be exchanged privately.

Sponsor provides the following information about the Singles:

- Female or male? If male, is he a Kohain?
- Age
- Height
- City of residence. Open to moving?
- Looks - anything outstanding
- Marital status
 - Never married
 - Widowed (If so, number of times)
 - Divorced (If so, number of times)
 - If children are involved:
 - Number of Children?
 - Who has custody?
- Religious Background:
 - FFB (Frum from Birth)
 - BT (Baal-Teshuvah) If so, how long?
 - Ger Tzedek If so, how long?
 - Ashkenazi or Sephardi?
- Current Religious Orientation:
 - Yeshivish – Learning only
 - Yeshivish/Secular – Learning /Working /College /Kovea Itim
 - Chassidish
 - Modern Orthodox
 - Schooling
 - Profession
 - Personality – include hobbies and pastimes
 - Family background
 - Miscellaneous information – to make the single come alive
 - If female, will she cover hair or not?
 - Would the single consider marrying a BT, Divorcee, Widow(er), or someone with children?
