## Tehillim Form

Thank you for committing yourself to be a participant in a L'Chaim Tehillim group. Sefer Tehillim has been divided into 18 sections to be recited by 18 singles or their sponsors. Each week YOU are responsible for reciting those 'Kapitluch' that have been assigned to you by your group organizer, as a 'Zechus' for finding a Shidduch for all those singles on the list.

The group will, IY"H, complete 'Sefer Tehillim' over the course of each week. This means that YOU are responsible for reciting your designated 'Kapitluch' at any time of the week before 'Shkiyah'. After saying Tehillim, you should read the Hebrew names of all the singles listed. Please note that on Shabbos the names of the singles should be omitted. In the 'Zechus' of Dovid HaMelech' and your Tefilos, may each single find his/her 'Zivug B'Karov'!
